

Silver Sequined Fringe Dress



Related Collection

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Description

Knee-length sleeveless dress covered with long vertical strips of silver sequins. The dress is worn with opaque tights, plain pumps, crystal or diamond drop earrings, and a stack of crystal or diamond bracelets. As indicated in an accompanying note, this photograph was taken in Japan in September 1965, when the designer took a month to show his collection there. Another version of this photo was featured in the November 1, 1965 issue of *Vogue*, where it is indicated that the photograph series was taken at the Museum of the Okura Hotel. The dress was part of Norell's fall/winter 1965-1966 collection, which was greatly inspired by the flapper trends of the late 1920s. This photograph was originally part of a larger scrapbook that can now be found in Box OSx-3, Folder 10.
