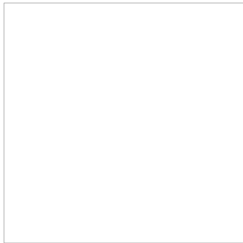


# Audio interview with Dee MacDonald-Miller

## Description

In this audio recording, Parsons School of Design Environmental Design alumna Dee MacDonald-Miller is interviewed by Joel Towers, executive dean of Parsons, and Wendy Scheir, director of the New School Archives and Special Collections.
